- 18-35 years of age

Qualifications

- ATHENA Young Professional Award Nominees may represent either the profit or not-for-profit sector.
- Previous ATHENA Young Professional Leadership Award Recipients are not eligible for nomination, however past nominees may be nominated again.

Completing the Form

- You are encouraged to work closely with your nominee to complete their nomination.
- Nominations for the ATHENA® Leadership Award must be submitted using this nomination form and format.

- The packet is VERY IMPORTANT and is a determining factor in deciding the winner.
- You may include supporting documents (articles, testimonials, etc) with your completed nomination form. **Limit 3 additional pages.**
